WHAT IS THE NCCGA?

The National Collegiate Club Golf Association is the governing body for non-varsity college golfers.

PLAYERS

Club golfers include former high school golfers, rec players, AJGA stars, fraternity members, and academic-focused students

Average scores: 72-112

TOURNAMENTS

The NCCGA hosts 2 weekend tournaments in 28 regions each semester.

Tournaments are held at quality courses centrally located in each region.

Schools can bring up to 8 golfers to compete on a team and the top 5 scores count for the team total.

Average cost for each tournament is about \$80 for a 2-day event.

Teams pay \$300 in dues per semester (\$150 for new teams) to join.

Individuals can compete in if your college does not have a club golf team.
